

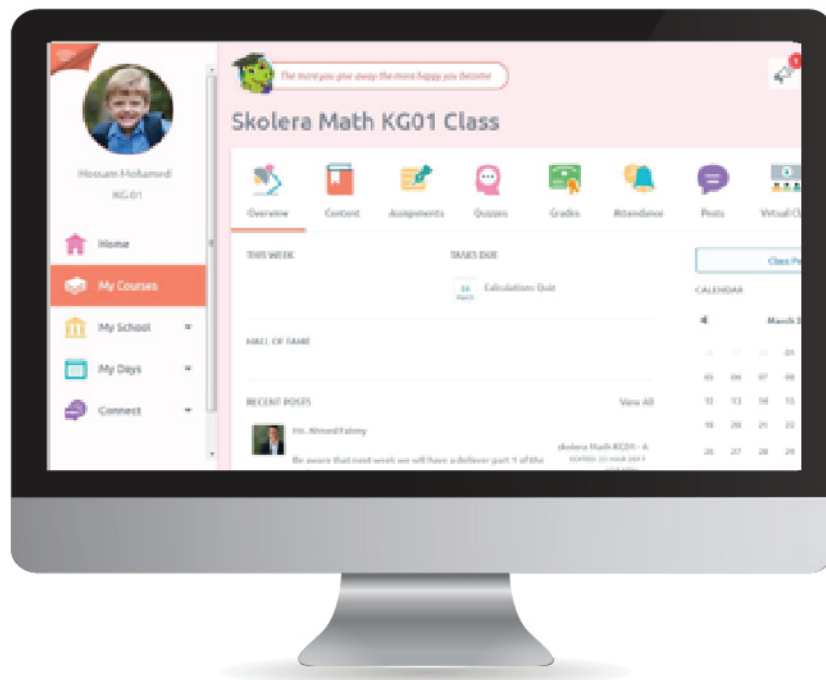
My Courses

Skolera is designed to provide students with all the tools and features they need to follow up on their progress, submit assignments, stay organized, and contact their teachers whenever needed.

The My Courses section of Skolera lists all the courses the student is enrolled in. You can click on a course name or image to go to the course homepage. The course homepage provides students with everything they need regarding their courses, from a general overview of the course and a collection of its digital content, to their grades, attendance, and even a virtual classroom.



The course homepage has the following tabs:



Overview

- On the top left-hand side of the Overview is a list of the lessons that will be covered this week.
- Beside that is a list of the assignments and quizzes that are due during the present week.
- Below that is the course's Hall of Fame that highlights students that have earned special recognition.
- Students can follow up on the latest posts by their teachers and classmates under that, as well.
- On the top right-hand corner of the Overview section, students can access the class policy, the monthly calendar with upcoming quizzes and assignments, and see a list of their fellow classmates.

Content

- Students can access course-related content uploaded by the teacher.
- The content is categorized as Topics, Subtopics and Lessons.
- Students simply click on the Content tab and select the desired topic.
- Click on the Lesson name to display the relevant Content.

Assignments

- The Assignments section provides students with access to upcoming and past assignments.
- Students can access the information and details of any assignment by simply clicking on it.
- If the assignment is still due and the student has not completed it yet, all he/she will be required to do is upload it if soft-copy responses are required, complete it using a text form if it is to be completed online, or simply hand in a hard copy at school.

Quizzes

- Students can also complete online quizzes created by their teachers via the quizzes section on the platform. To solve a quiz online, click on the quiz name to open the details page, then click Solve now.

Grades

- Students can check their grades for the course anytime by clicking on the Grades tab.

Attendance

- The Attendance tab provides students with a record of the days in which they were present, late, excused or absent.

Posts

- The Posts tab allows students to communicate with the whole class. Students can ask questions, discuss topics that were recently taught, or talk about other class-related issues.

Ask Teacher

- Students can ask their teachers questions anytime on anything related to their course, performance, and attendance.
- A list of the teachers of the class appears once the student clicks on the text box for Teacher Name.
- You can send the message to one or more teacher(s).
- The student then simply types in the subject of the message, the message itself, select what the question is about (whether it's about a quiz, assignment, report, excuse, etc.), and then clicks Send Message.
